OVERVIEW

Mark A. Reigelman II is a New York based artist whose work has been exhibited in public spaces, galleries, and museums across the country. Mark earned recent acclaim when Americans for the Arts named his installation *Wood-Pile* as one of the top 40 public art projects in the United States. He was also recently awarded the Neighborhood Improvement Award from Detroit Shoreway for his *Blue Bird* installation as well as the Graue Award for a public project titled, *Manifest Destiny!* which will be unveiled in San Francisco in late 2011. Mark's latest public art endeavor, *White Cloud*, was a commissioned installation by the Cleveland Museum of Art in partnership with Cleveland Public Art to transform the facade of the museum's famed 1916 building. His *Bike Rack* project, a public bike station in downtown Cleveland, has earned LEED Silver certification by the USGBC. Mark is a member of the American Design Club (AmDC) and co-founder of the New York based creative collective Art Stars and bi-coastal public art collaborative Chapman/Reigelman. Reigelman has worked with designers such as Isaac Mizrahi, Gyll, Ron Gilad, Dror, Montana Knox and Rockwell Group. Reigelman's work has been included in publications such as The New York Times (NYC), New York Magazine (NYC), Frame (Netherlands), L'uomo Vogue (Italy), Public Design (Korea) and Télé Star (France).

PROFESSIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

"White Cloud" | Cleveland Museum of Art | Cleveland, OH
Comprised of nearly 100 eight-foot weather balloons with light projections the installation was intended to create a dreamlike tableau, temporarily transforming the architecture.

"Wrap" | Euclid Corridor Project | Cleveland, OH
Part of the multi-million dollar Euclid Corridor Project "Wrap" is a collection of custom steel reinforced cast concrete site furnishings scattered along Euclid Avenue. Conceived in the spirit of whimsy, the planters are designed to evoke bouquets wrapped in paper, fresh from the florist.

"Stair Squares" | Brooklyn Borough Hall | Brooklyn, NY
Brooklyn Borough Hall Brooklyn, NY/2007
A site-specific collection of public furniture pieces which temporarily rested on the cascading steps of New York's Brooklyn Borough Hall. They were designed not only as an aesthetic asset, but as a functional asset as well. They were strategically integrated into the urban landscape and incorporated into daily life.

"Wood-Pile" | Cleveland Museum of Art | Cleveland, OH
The main attraction during the Cleveland Museum of Art's East Wing Grand Opening, "Wood-Pile" stretched almost 500 feet along the Museum's Eastern facade. Consisting of 18,720 recyclable polyethylene tubes the sculpture paid tribute to ancient midsummer-related tradition of bonfires. Americans for the Arts acknowledged the installation as one of the country's best public art projects of 2009.
